HOMEWORK & STUDY

- ◉ Entering of all homework in student's homework journal. NOT JUST WRITTEN WORK.
- ◉ Completion and presentation of written assignments when due.
- ◉ Preparation of classwork-reading, compulsory learning and revision all need to be addressed.
- ◉ On-going revision and preparation for class tests, House and State Examinations.



HOMework & STUDY

- ◉ Recommended duration of study time 1 to 2 hrs five/six days a week
- ◉ Prepare a study/homework plan.
- ◉ After school study for exam years depending on demand



CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT & HOUSE EXAMS



- ◉ Each subject will have class tests or continuous assessments.
- ◉ There will be Christmas and Summer Exams of 1 or 1.5 hr in length.
- ◉ Exams should be a positive experience.
- ◉ Students should be encouraged to challenge themselves.
- ◉ The First Year Parent/Teacher Meeting is the ideal time to bring minor concerns to the attention of the subject teacher.
- ◉ Parents/guardians will receive a digital school report twice a year. This is available through vsware.

PRACTICAL MATTERS



- All textbooks and copies should have the students name on them.
- All items of clothing should be labelled with student's name.
- The school should be informed regarding student's health issues (medical form).
- Please inform us of any changes to your contact details, particularly phone numbers should they change.
- Students are required to have their mobile phones switched off and on the desk and only use them in class if directed by the teacher. They are only allowed to use them at break time and lunch time in their classrooms only. Our use of mobile phones is subject to ongoing review and any changes will be communicated to parents.
- Could we also please ask parents/guardians not to call students to their mobile during class time. If you need to contact your daughter during the school day you should contact reception first.



MATTERS FINANCIAL

- Student Expenses include payment for lockers, student journal
- Voluntary contribution covers 24hr student insurance, photocopying and printing, practical subjects, contributes to cost of guest speakers etc
- Money can be requested for Buses/Matches
- Large sums of money, expensive items should not be brought to school
- As part of being an inclusive school we don't want any student excluded for financial reasons
