

Leaving Cert Vocational Programme (LCVP)



- Two Year Programme – 5th and 6th year
- Two Classes per week
- Leaving Certificate Exam - Two parts:
 - (a) Portfolio - 60% (due in March, 6th Yr)

Six items in total e.g. Curriculum Vitae, Career Investigation
 - (b) Written – 40% (due in May, 6th Yr)

Note: Portfolio work is completed in March in 6th year and the written examination is completed in May in 6th year.

Types of Activities undertaken as part of the LCVP Programme:

- Visits In
- Visits Out
- Preparation for World of Work e.g. C.V, Mock Interviews.
- Work Experience/Work Shadowing – 4 days usually in Feb. in 5th year.
- Undertaking Enterprise Activities

Certification

Grades for Link Modules are awarded as follows:

Distinction: 80 – 100%
(**66 points** – H₄ Higher Level Paper)

Merit: 65 – 79%
(**46 points** – H₆ Higher Level Paper)

Pass: 50 – 64%
(**28 points** – O₄ Ordinary Level Paper)

Most colleges accept LCVP for points purposes, some exceptions would be:

1. NCAD
2. St. Angela's, Sligo

Note: Not everyone is suitable for LCVP, depends on your Vocational Subject Groupings (VSG's – see below)
